



Cashless Catering School Management Systems

For those schools who are thinking about procuring or wanting to find out more about cashless systems for their school meals service.

It is a known fact that the benefits of having a cashless system can reduce the administration time due to parent's ability to pay on-line or through revaluation units located in the school. There is accurate reporting on the number and type of meals taken including the uptake of free school meals, accurate stock inventory and wastage reports, menu scheduling and food analysis. The system can also be used for other purposes such as recording monies received from parents for School Trips.
